Terms and Conditions of Use for Venture

Welcome to Venture, a service designed to inspire meaningful, real-world connection through challenges, questions, and prompts shared between people. Venture is operated by Grace Brinkman Creative LLC, an Arizona limited liability company ("Venture," "we," "us," or "our").

By downloading, accessing, creating an account for, or using the Venture mobile application, website, or related services (collectively, the "Service"), you agree to these Terms and Conditions ("Terms"). These Terms form a legally binding agreement between you ("User," "you," or "your") and the operating company.

If you do not agree to these Terms, you may not access or use the Service.

1. Eligibility

You must be at least 13 years old to create or use a Venture account. Venture is not intended for children under 13, and we do not knowingly permit children under 13 to create or use accounts.

During account creation, you are asked to enter your full date of birth. Venture uses the date you provide to determine whether you meet the minimum-age requirement and to apply age-based content restrictions. Account creation is rejected when the entered date indicates that the person is under 13.

Because the birth date is entered manually by the user, Venture cannot independently guarantee that the information provided is accurate. You represent and warrant that the information you provide is complete and accurate and that you meet any higher minimum age, parental-authorization requirement, or other eligibility requirement that applies under the laws of your country or region.

If we learn or reasonably believe that an account belongs to a child under 13, or that a user does not meet an applicable eligibility requirement, we may suspend or delete the account and take reasonable steps to remove associated personal information.

Venture may designate certain content as available to all eligible users, users age 16 and older, or users age 18 and older. Access is based on the date of birth provided during account creation. All content on Venture is subject to these terms.

2. User Responsibilities and Prohibited Conduct

You are responsible for your use of the Service and for all text, prompts, Ventures, photographs, videos, audio, messages, comments, proof submissions, and other information or material that you submit, send, upload, publish, or share through Venture ("Content").

You agree to use the Service only for lawful purposes and in accordance with these Terms. You must have all rights, permissions, and consents necessary to submit or share your Content.

You agree not to:

- Harass, threaten, stalk, intimidate, exploit, shame, bully, or harm another person.
- Encourage another person to perform an unsafe, illegal, degrading, dangerous, or harmful act.
- Promote hatred, violence, discrimination, terrorism, criminal activity, or self-harm.
- Share, request, solicit, or distribute pornography, sexual exploitation material, or sexually explicit content.
- Sexualize, exploit, groom, endanger, or solicit sexual content from a minor.
- Impersonate another person, misrepresent your identity or age, or create a deceptive account.
- Upload or disclose another person's private, confidential, or identifying information without permission.

- Post Content that infringes intellectual-property, publicity, privacy, or other legal rights.
- Send spam, scams, fraudulent invitations, malicious links, or unauthorized promotions.
- Attempt to gain unauthorized access to another account, the Service, or Venture's systems.
- Interfere with the Service, introduce malicious code, scrape information without authorization, or circumvent security, blocking, moderation, or age-restriction features.
- Use another person's contact information for an invitation without a legitimate reason or authorization to contact that person.
- Use the Service in violation of any applicable local, state, national, or international law.

You are responsible for deciding whether a Venture is safe and appropriate before accepting or attempting it. No Venture is mandatory, and you should decline any Venture that is unlawful, dangerous, uncomfortable, or beyond your abilities.

3. Content Ownership, Sharing, and License

You retain ownership of the Content you create and share through Venture.

Direct Ventures are ordinarily visible only to the sender and intended recipient. When creating certain Venture prompts, the creator may decide whether the prompt is shareable and searchable within Venture. If a prompt is designated as non-shareable, it remains between the sender and recipient, and the recipient may not publish the Venture as a post through the applicable feature.

When you choose to publish a post or other shareable Content, it may be visible to all signed-in Venture users and may appear in feeds, profiles, searches, rankings, hashtag pages, interest pages, notifications, and other areas of the Service. Venture profiles and Content are not intended to be available to the general public on the open internet without authentication.

By submitting Content through the Service, you grant Grace Brinkman Creative LLC a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, sub-licensable license to host, store, reproduce, process, adapt, compress, transcode, create technical derivatives of, display, distribute, and make the Content available as reasonably necessary to operate, provide, secure, moderate, and improve Venture.

This license allows us to:

- Deliver Content to the users and audiences selected through Venture's features.
- Generate thumbnails, previews, playback versions, and other technical media formats.
- Display published Content in feeds, profiles, searches, rankings, hashtags, interests, and notifications.
- Investigate reports, enforce these Terms, and protect users and the Service.

This license does not transfer ownership of your Content to us. It ordinarily ends when the Content is deleted from active systems, except where the Content remains in another user's records, has been copied by another user, must be retained for safety or legal reasons, or remains temporarily in backups, caches, or logs.

Other users may screenshot, record, save, or copy Content they can access. Venture cannot control copies made independently by other users.

4. Privacy, Invitations, and Account Deletion

Venture's collection, use, disclosure, retention, and deletion of personal information are described in the Venture Privacy Policy, available at <https://venturesocialnetwork.com/privacy>. The Privacy Policy is incorporated into these Terms by reference.

Venture does not sell or rent personal information and does not display third-party advertising. Venture uses Firebase Analytics to operate, understand, secure, and improve the Service, not for cross-context behavioral advertising.

When a user initiates the Invite Friend feature and selects a person through Apple's contact picker, Venture may receive and store a selected first or display name, selected phone number, normalized phone-number value, invitation token, invitation link, and related invitation metadata. Venture does not scan or upload the user's entire address book.

The invitation is presented through Apple's Messages composer and is sent only if the user chooses to send it. The user represents that they are authorized to contact the invited person.

If an invitation remains unclaimed, the invited person's contact-derived information, claim credentials, and related invitation document are automatically removed or redacted after approximately 90 days. A minimal record that does not contain the invited person's contact information or usable claim credentials may remain for history, security, or aggregate operational purposes.

A non-user whose information was used for an invitation may request earlier removal by contacting support@venturesocialnetwork.com.

Signed-in users may initiate account deletion within Venture. Account deletion is designed to delete or anonymize the account, profile, owned posts and media, Ventures, notifications, social relationships, and other associated information, subject to limited exceptions described in the Privacy Policy.

Comments placed on another user's Content may remain after account deletion but may be disassociated from the deleted user and shown using an "Account Deleted" representation. Venture may also retain limited deleted-account identifiers, reports, moderation evidence, security records, legally required information, and temporary backup or cache copies where reasonably necessary.

Deleting the Venture application from a device does not by itself delete the user's Venture account.

5. Venture Intellectual Property

Except for User Content, all intellectual-property rights in the Service - including its software, source code, functionality, interface, graphics, designs, logos, branding, and original materials - are owned by or licensed to Grace Brinkman Creative LLC.

Subject to your compliance with these Terms, Venture grants you a limited, personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to access and use the Service for its intended purposes.

You may not copy, reproduce, modify, reverse engineer, distribute, sell, license, create derivative works from, or commercially exploit any portion of the Service unless applicable law permits the activity or the operating company gives you written permission.

6. Safety, User-Generated Content, and Assumption of Risk

Venture is designed to encourage social interaction and real-world exploration. Venture does not continuously monitor, pre-screen, approve, supervise, or verify all user-submitted Content or the completion of Ventures.

Venture may use automated restrictions, prohibited-word controls, age-based content restrictions, user reports, blocking tools, and manual review to address potentially harmful or prohibited activity. We may review Content and

related account information when a report is submitted, when a safety concern is identified, or when reasonably necessary to enforce these Terms. These measures do not guarantee that all inappropriate, dangerous, unlawful, or harmful Content will be detected or removed.

You acknowledge and agree that:

- Every Venture is optional.
- You are responsible for deciding whether a Venture is lawful, safe, and appropriate.
- You participate in or attempt Ventures voluntarily and at your own risk.
- You must not pressure another person to participate in a Venture.
- You should not perform any Venture that makes you feel unsafe or uncomfortable.
- You must not perform a Venture that could violate the law, damage property, cause injury, invade privacy, or endanger you or another person.
- You should use appropriate judgment, supervision, protective equipment, and professional assistance where relevant.
- Content created by other users does not represent the views or instructions of Grace Brinkman Creative LLC.

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, Grace Brinkman Creative LLC is not responsible for injury, property damage, financial loss, emotional harm, or other consequences caused by a user's decision to create, send, accept, attempt, or complete a Venture or by another user's conduct.

Venture is not an emergency service. If you or another person may be in immediate danger, contact the appropriate local emergency service.

7. Reports, Content Removal, Suspension, and Termination

Users may report Content or accounts and may block other users through the tools provided in Venture.

We may investigate reports and review relevant Content, account information, activity records, and limited related evidence when reasonably necessary to protect users, enforce these Terms, prevent abuse, or comply with law.

We may, to the extent permitted by applicable law and based on the circumstances:

- Restrict the visibility or distribution of Content.
- Remove or disable access to Content.
- Issue a warning.
- Limit account features.
- Suspend or terminate an account.
- Preserve relevant records or evidence.
- Prevent a person from creating another account.
- Refer credible safety threats, suspected child exploitation, fraud, or unlawful conduct to appropriate authorities.

We may take action when we reasonably believe that a user has violated these Terms, created a risk of harm, misused the Service, infringed another person's rights, or exposed Venture or others to legal or security risk.

Where reasonably practical and legally appropriate, we may provide notice of an enforcement decision. We are not required to disclose information that would compromise another person's privacy, safety, an investigation, security measures, or a legal obligation.

We do not guarantee that every report will be reviewed immediately or resolved in a particular manner or within a particular period.

8. No Warranties

The Service is provided "as is" and "as available" to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law. We do not guarantee that the Service will always be available, uninterrupted, error-free, secure, accurate, or suitable for every purpose.

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, Grace Brinkman Creative LLC disclaims all express, implied, and statutory warranties, including warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, title, quiet enjoyment, and non-infringement.

Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits a warranty, consumer right, or legal protection that cannot lawfully be excluded or limited in the user's country or region.

9. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, Grace Brinkman Creative LLC and its members, officers, employees, contractors, agents, licensors, and service providers will not be liable for any indirect, incidental, special, exemplary, consequential, or punitive damages, or for any loss of profits, revenue, data, goodwill, opportunity, or use, arising from or related to:

- Your access to or use of, or inability to access or use, the Service.
- A Venture that you or another user creates, sends, accepts, attempts, or completes.
- Content or conduct of another user.
- Unauthorized access to or alteration of information.
- Suspension, termination, deletion, or moderation performed under these Terms.
- Service interruptions, errors, or third-party services.

These limitations apply regardless of the legal theory and even if Venture was advised that the loss was possible.

Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits liability for fraud, willful misconduct, death or personal injury caused by negligence where such liability cannot lawfully be excluded, or any other liability that applicable law does not permit us to exclude or limit.

Some countries or regions do not permit certain warranty disclaimers or liability limitations. In those locations, these provisions apply only to the maximum extent permitted by law.

10. Governing Law and Disputes

These Terms and any dispute arising from or relating to the Service are governed by the laws of the State of Arizona, United States, without regard to its conflict-of-law rules.

Subject to any mandatory rights or procedures available under applicable law, disputes that cannot be resolved informally will be brought in a state or federal court having jurisdiction in Arizona, and you and Grace Brinkman Creative LLC consent to the jurisdiction of those courts.

Before filing a claim, you agree to contact support@venturesocialnetwork.com and provide a reasonable opportunity for us to attempt to resolve the dispute informally.

If you are a consumer residing outside Arizona, nothing in this section deprives you of mandatory consumer protections, dispute procedures, or the right to bring a claim in a location that the laws of your country or region require.

11. Changes to These Terms

We may update these Terms to reflect changes to Venture, applicable laws, safety requirements, or our business practices.

The revised Terms will display an updated "Last Updated" date. We may provide notice of material changes through the Service, by email, or through another reasonable method.

Where required by law, we will request affirmative acceptance or consent before applying a material change. Otherwise, your continued use of the Service after the revised Terms become effective constitutes acceptance of the revised Terms.

If you do not agree to revised Terms, you must stop using the Service and may delete your account.
